Weather: Average Summer High: 89° F/32° C; Average Summer Low: 67° F/19° C. Salt Lake City has low humidity, making these temperatures more comfortable.

Altitude: Salt Lake City's official elevation is 4,330 feet/1,320 meters above sea level. Those coming from lower elevations should be sure to drink plenty of water, to help adjust to the altitude.

Suggested Attire: Summer is warm but not humid. This conference is informal, so bring comfortable, lightweight business or casual clothes. Comfortable walking shoes for daytime leisure activities also are suggested. Hotels and meeting rooms are air conditioned and can be very cool, so long sleeves or light sweaters are also recommended.
